Missions Updates

Missions Board is collecting donations with Interfaith Action to support migrant families. Full list of donation items (see page 5) and collection bin is located in the church entry way. The items will be presented during the Celebration of the Harvest on Sunday, October 1 at 3 p.m. at Tabor Hill at an Interfaith service (Pastor Jeffrey will be participating) [see page 4 for flyer].

Missions also asks everyone interested in United Way of Southwest Michigan's Rake-a-Difference Day of Action for Seniors to mark their calendars for Thursday, November 9. Sign-ups are due by October 13 in order to receive a t-shirt, but if you forget to sign-up, we'll still take all the help we can get on November 9th.

Missions Board, in partnership with the Rummage Leadership Team, has sent off funding to aid ongoing, crisis situations throughout the world: \$2,000 to World Central Kitchen (aiding both Maui and hurricane relief in Florida and coastline), \$2,000 to UCC Disaster Relief (responding to request for aid in Maui), and \$1,000 to the Aid Centre in Warsaw Poland, supporting Ukrainian Refugees. Missions Board also donated \$3,000 from their own budget to add to the aid sent to Maui.

Following the Fall Sale, Missions and Rummage Leaders will collaborate further to determine where best to send aid, monitoring hurricane season and ongoing crises.
